CJUS ELECTIVES
Students must complete six criminal justice electives. At least one elective must be upper level (300-400).

~If completing PSY-136, SEE Math or Science (SR, SR-L or QL) must be a Quantitative Literacy (QL) course with a MATH prefix.

^MATH-129 Foundational Statistics may fulfill MATH-136. Students receive credit for only one of the following Statistics courses: MATH-136, PSY-136, or MATH-129.

GENERAL EDUCATION NOTES

Stevenson Educational Experience (SEE) courses are identified in blue.

- Specific courses that fulfill SEE requirements are listed in the SU Catalog and Student Planning.
- Students must complete all SEE and major requirements and earn a minimum of 120 credits. A minimum of 15 credits must be upper level.

*HUMANITIES classes must be from at least three different disciplines.

**SOCIAL SCIENCE classes must be from two different disciplines.
